

Bardia National Park Safari, Nepal



Nepal - Extension Options



After your adventurous time in the Himalaya why not add an exciting Jungle Safari to your holiday in Nepal.

The Royal Bardia National Park is situated in the remote west of Nepal and is much less visited than Chitwan. It has abundant wildlife and you will stay at Tiger Tops Karnali Lodge, the longest established and best lodge in the area so your experience there will have a degree of exclusivity in comparison to more popular Chitwan. As it is rather a long journey to get there we normally recommend a 3 night stay in Bardia although a 2 night stay is also available.

From the lodge you will be able to participate in safaris and have the chance of seeing some of the country's wonderful wildlife, including wild elephant, rhinoceros, leopard, deer, wild boar and if you are lucky, the famous Royal Bengal Tiger. There is also the possibility of visiting the villages of the Tharu tribal people that surround the lodge.

Karnali Lodge

Set on the edge of Bardia National Park, Karnali Lodge is owned and run in conjunction with Tiger Tops. The lodge's double rooms are complete with en suite bathroom. There is a central dining area serving both Western and Nepali cuisine.

Bardia, 3 Day Itinerary

Day 1 Transfer to Kathmandu Airport from your hotel. Fly to Nepalgunj and transfer to your lodge (approx 2hrs). Briefing on arrival. Afternoon jungle activities e.g. elephant experience, nature walks, jungle drives. Overnight Karnali Lodge.

Day 2 Full day's jungle activities, e.g. bird watching, gentle rafting along the Bheri or Karnali Rivers and jungle walk. Overnight Karnali Lodge.

Day 3 Transfer to Nepalgunj and fly to Kathmandu. Transfer to your overnight hotel.

£1,135 per person* (based on 2 people sharing a double/twin room). Single room supplement £300.



Bardia, 4 Day Itinerary

Day 1 Transfer to Kathmandu Airport from your hotel. Fly to Nepalgunj and transfer to your lodge (approx 2hrs). Briefing on arrival. Afternoon jungle activities e.g. elephant experience, nature walks, jungle drives. Overnight Karnali Lodge.

Day 4 Transfer to Nepalgunj and fly to Kathmandu. Transfer to your overnight hotel.
