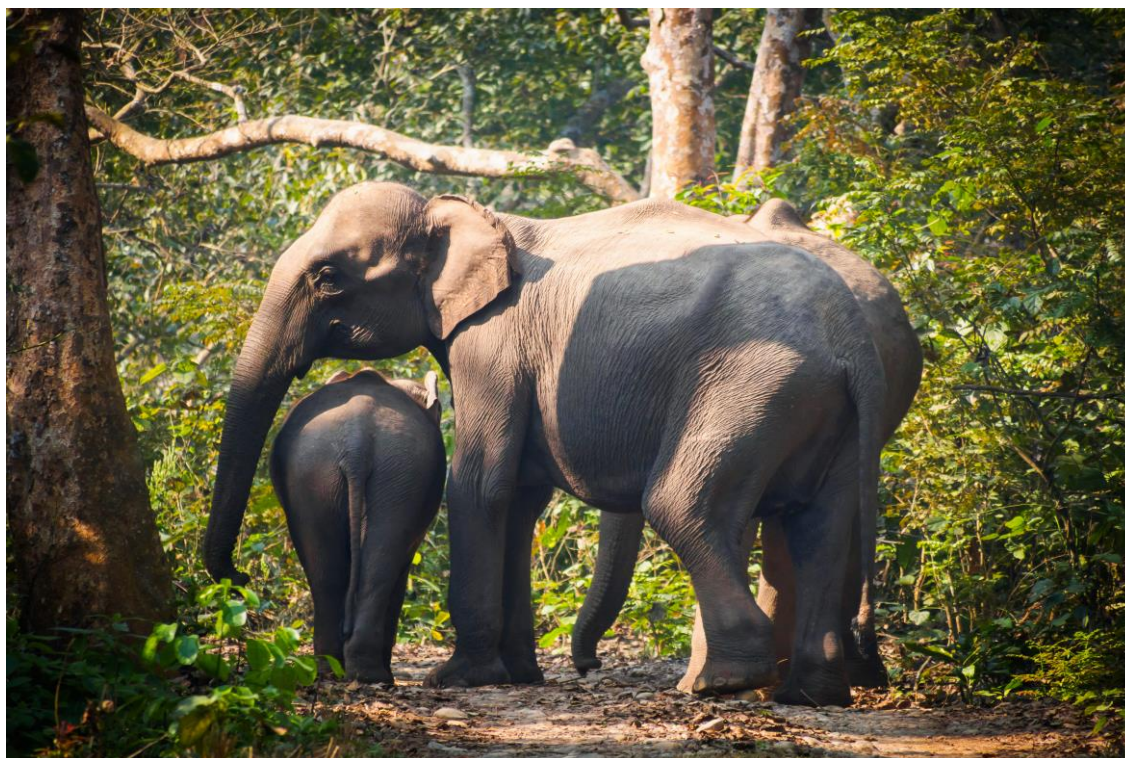


Bardia National Park Safari, Nepal



Nepal - Extension Options



After your adventurous time in the Himalaya why not add an exciting jungle safari to your holiday in Nepal.

The Royal Bardia National Park is situated in the remote west of Nepal and is much less visited than Chitwan. It has abundant wildlife and you will stay at Tiger Tops Karnali Lodge, the longest established and best lodge in the area, so your experience there will have a degree of exclusivity in comparison to more popular Chitwan. As it is rather a long journey to get there we normally recommend a 3 night stay in Bardia.

From the lodge you will be able to participate in various safari activities in the company of expert guides including jeep and river safaris, walking safaris and specialist bird watching excursions. You will therefore have many chances of seeing some of the country's wonderful wildlife, including wild elephant, rhinoceros, leopard, deer, wild boar and, if you are lucky, the famous Royal Bengal Tiger. There may also be the opportunity to visit the villages of the Tharu tribal people that surround the lodge.

Karnali Lodge

Set on the edge of Bardia National Park, the eco-friendly Karnali Lodge is owned and run in conjunction with Tiger Tops. The lodge's stylish, rooms come complete with en suite bathrooms and you have a choice of Traditional rooms or Signature rooms. There is an attractive central dining area serving both Western and Nepali cuisine using produce grown at the lodge's small organic farm.

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Bardia Karnali Lodge - 3 night / 4 Day Extension

- Day 1 Transfer to Kathmandu Airport from your hotel. Fly to Nepalgunj and transfer to your lodge (approx 2hrs). Briefing on arrival. Afternoon jungle activities e.g. elephant experience, nature walks, jungle drives. Overnight Karnali Lodge.
- Day 2 Full day's jungle activities e.g. bird watching, gentle rafting along the Bheri or Karnali Rivers and jungle walk. Overnight Karnali Lodge.
- Day 3 Full day's jungle activities e.g. bird watching, gentle rafting along the Bheri or Karnali Rivers and jungle walk. Overnight.
- Day 4 Transfer to Nepalgunj and fly to Kathmandu. Transfer to your overnight hotel.

Traditional Room - £1,150 per person (based on two people sharing), £1,450 (single traveller)

Signature room - £1,250 per person (based on two people sharing), £1,595 (single traveller)

Prices include: Kathmandu airport/hotel transfers; flights Kathmandu/Nepalgunj/Kathmandu; transfers to and from Karnali Lodge in Bardia National Park; safari activities accompanied by an experienced naturalist; all meals.

The above prices do not include: Kathmandu hotel nights, tips and drinks at the lodge.



Extra hotel nights in Kathmandu:

Should you require an additional night's hotel accommodation in Kathmandu, before or after your safari, we would be happy to arrange this for you at either of our two partner hotels or at another hotel of your choice.

Shangri La Hotel: £60 per person (based on a double/twin share room). Single Room £120.*

Dwarika's Hotel: From £130 per person in spring season or £150 per person in autumn (based on a double/twin share room). Single Room £230 in spring or £270 in autumn.
