

# Iguazú Falls



## Extension Option - Argentina



If you are travelling to or from Buenos Aires on your Mountain Kingdoms holiday you can add extra nights to enjoy an extension to Iguazú Falls, one of nature's most awe-inspiring sights. The falls straddle the border between Argentina and Brazil, stretch for almost 3km and comprise 275 separate cascades thundering down from a height of around 70m. On this extension you will spend time on both sides enjoying the magnificent views and contrasting scenery. You will stay at a good quality hotel at Puerto Iguazu on the Argentine side, and be accompanied by an English-speaking guide.

### 2 night extension

**Day 1 - Transfer to Buenos Aires airport. Fly to Puerto Iguazú. Transfer to hotel. Afternoon Brazilian falls tour.**

This morning you will be picked up from your hotel in Buenos Aires and transferred to the domestic airport for your flight to Puerto Iguazú where your guide will meet you. After checking in to your hotel you will cross the bridge, Tancredo Neves, which joins Puerto Iguazú with the town of Foz do Iguazú in Brazil. You will need to pass through customs formalities on both sides of the bridge.

Entering Iguazú National Park, you go first to the visitor centre where you board one of the park's tourist buses. Your tour will visit several viewpoints that will reveal stunning vistas of both the Argentinian and Brazilian cascades. You will see Rio Iguazú Canyon, Salto Rivadavia and Tres Mosqueteros before ending at Devil's Throat overlook where you can feel the raw power of the falls and fully appreciate how they got their name which means 'great waters'.

## Day 2 - Full day tour of the Argentinian falls.

You will have plenty of time today to explore the vast expanse of Iguazú Falls National Park on the Argentine side. Here you will be walking and travelling through rainforest with a huge variety of ferns, orchids, begonias, birds and butterflies. Because the park covers such a large area you will begin by taking the park's small tourist train to reach your first stop, a ride of up to 20 minutes. The park has many elevated walkways which are divided into three sections: the lower section (1.6km), the upper section (0.8km) and Devil's Throat (1.2km) each of which give access to viewpoints of different parts of the falls. First of all you will walk to once again see the falls at Devil's Throat. This is considered the most spectacular viewpoint of all as you are on a deck that projects out over the thundering water below. Then you will walk the elevated Upper Circuit trail from where you can observe the Dos Hermanas, Bosetti, Bernabe, Mendez and M'Bigua cascades. Finally you will take the Lower Circuit giving views of the bottom of Dos Hermanas, Alvar Nunez, San Martin and Bella Vista falls.

There is also the opportunity to take the Gran Aventura Tour (payable locally) which combines a 'jungle' jeep drive and an exhilarating boat ride to the base of the falls. Be prepared to get wet though if you take this tour!

## Day 3 - Transfer to Puerto Iguazú airport. Fly to Buenos Aires. Transfer to hotel or to the international airport

After breakfast you will return to the local airport for your flight back to Buenos Aires. On arrival you will either be transferred to your hotel in Buenos Aires or to the international airport for your onward flight - depending on your holiday arrangements.

## 3 night extension

We also offer a 3 night extension which spends a full day on each side of the falls. For this itinerary you will have time at leisure when you arrive at Puerto Iguazú on Day 1. You will then spend Day 2 on the Brazilian side of the falls and Day 3 exploring the Argentine side. You will then fly back to Buenos Aires on Day 4.



### Hotel Grand Panoramic Iguazú

Only 10 miles from Iguazú Falls National Park and with views of the Iguazú River and Triple Frontier, the Grand Panoramic is well situated for visitors to the area. The hotel has attractive landscaped gardens, a pool, bar and restaurant, and standard rooms are well-equipped with a minibar, air-conditioning and free Wi-Fi.
